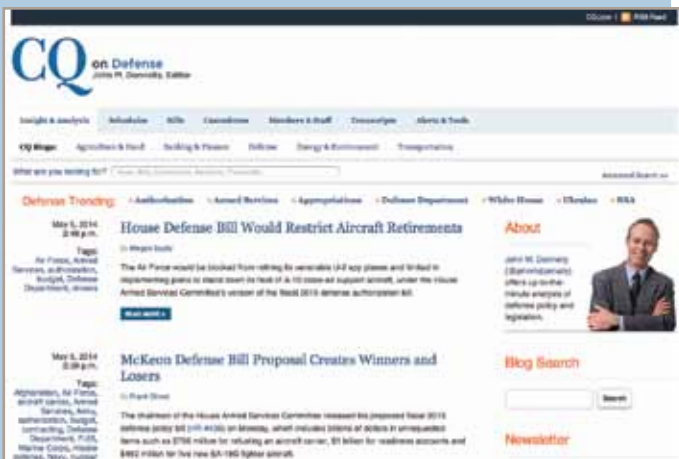

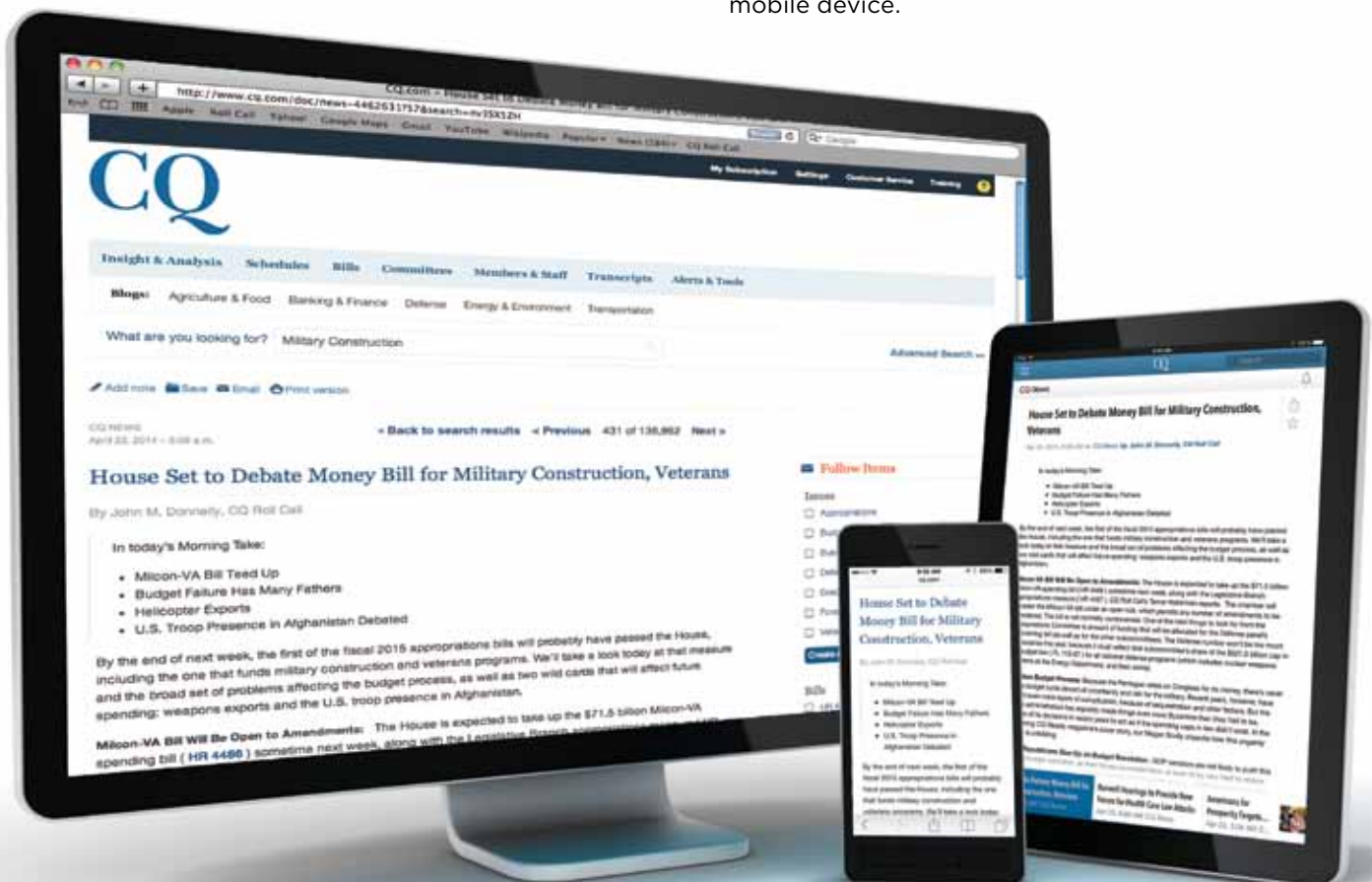

Water Projects Authorization

This Fact Sheet deals with HR 3080 , Water Resources Reform and Development Act, which the House will consider on Wednesday.

The bill authorizes U.S. Army Corps of Engineers water-resource-related activities — including port dredging, inland locks and dams, and flood control projects. It establishes a new process for water project selection and deauthorizations. It permits greater participation in water projects and establishes a pilot program for public-private partnerships. It increases expenditures from the Harbor Maintenance Trust Fund and requires a study to identify possible new revenue streams for the Inland Waterways Trust Fund.
